## RESCISSION OF VHA DIRECTIVE 1165, LEADERSHIP POSITIONS IN MENTAL HEALTH

- **1.** By direction of the Office of the Under Secretary for Health, Veterans Health Administration (VHA), VHA Directive 1165, Leadership Positions in Mental Health, dated May 12, 2021, is rescinded.
- **2.** Providing high quality mental health and suicide prevention services remains a top VHA priority. To support this mission, it is essential to recruit and hire the most qualified individuals, regardless of their discipline, for leadership positions in mental health programs. Recruiting across disciplines helps to ensure both a high-quality corps of mental health program leaders and a diversity of professional backgrounds. This approach is most consistent with interprofessional practice, which is the cornerstone of VA mental health programs. High functioning teams addressing behavioral and mental health needs require collaboration among diverse professions.
- **3.** While the Office of Mental Health fully supports the principles outlined in VHA Directive 1165, enforcement of this directive is not practical as each mental health program leadership position is unique, and sites require flexibility in posting across disciplines based on their unique characteristics and existing staffing.
