MEMORANDUM FOR THE ASSISTANT SECRETARY FOR HUMAN RESOURCES AND ADMINISTRATION/OPERATIONS, SECURITY, AND PREPAREDNESS

SUBJECT: Delegation of Authority to Approve or Disapprove Collective Bargaining Agreements or Amendments that are not Subject to a Controlling Higher-Level Agreement (VIEWS 11500279)

1. DELEGATION. The Assistant Secretary for Human Resources and Administration/ Operations, Security, and Preparedness is delegated the authority to approve or disapprove collective bargaining agreements or amendments that are not subject to a controlling higher-level agreement.

2. AUTHORITIES.

38 U.S.C. § 303, Secretary of Veterans Affairs.

38 U.S.C. § 512, Delegation of authority; assignment of functions and duties.

5 U.S.C. § 7114(c), Representation rights and duties.

- 3. RESTRICTIONS. The Assistant Secretary for Human Resources and Administration/ Operations, Security, and Preparedness shall carry out this authority after appropriate consultation with the Administrations and the Office of General Counsel.
- **4. REDELEGATION.** The Assistant Secretary for Human Resources and Administration/ Operations, Security, and Preparedness may further redelegate this authority in writing to the Chief Human Capital Officer and/or Executive Director, Labor Management Relations.
- **5. EFFECTIVE DATE AND EXPIRATION DATE.** This delegation is effective upon signature. This delegation will remain in effect for 4 years unless otherwise rescinded, modified, or superseded.
