Introduction

This reminder update releases these revisions and updates to the existing national cervical cancer screening reminder definition and dialogs.

Revisions:

- 1. Simplified text around guidance
- 2. Added default condition statements at the term level for the VA-WH HPV TESTING NEGATIVE and VA-WH HPV TESTING POSITIVE reminder terms
- 3. Removed national health factors from the VA-WH HPV TESTING NEGATIVE and VA-WH HPV TESTING POSITIVE reminder terms. Added those health factors to two new reminder terms, VA-WH HPV TESTING NEGATIVE HEALTH FACTORS and VA-WH HPV TESTING POSITIVE HEALTH FACTORS.
- 4. Created three new reminder terms for primary HPV lab tests, VA-WH HRHPV FDA APP 5Y POSITIVE HEALTH FACTORS, VA-WH HRHPV FDA APP 5Y POSITIVE, and VA-WH HRHPV FDA APP 5Y NEGATIVE.
- 5. Revised logic so reminder becomes applicable to a patient who has a cytology, HPV test, or new frequency documented more recently than documentation that the patient should no longer be screened.
- 6. Revised the VA-WH PAP SMEAR SCREENING CODES and VA-CERVICAL CA/ABNORMAL PAP reminder taxonomies to ignore problem list codes.
 - a. Many diagnosis codes have been removed from the VA-CERVICAL CA/ABNORMAL PAP reminder taxonomy.
- 7. Revised screening section of dialog.
 - a. New option of cervical cytology ordered and obtained.
 - i. New procedure code embedded to inform eQM.
 - b. New option of cervical cytology and HPV ordered and obtained.
 - i. Two new procedure codes embedded to inform eQM.
 - c. New option of FDA approved HrHPV for primary screen ordered and obtained. This option can be hidden for sites that do not have the stand-alone FDA approved primary screening HPV test.
 - i. New procedure code embedded to inform eQM.
 - d. New option added for documenting encounter diagnosis.
- 8. Added new option for documenting outside or previous positive stand-alone FDA approved primary screening HPV test results.
- 9. Added new option for documenting outside or previous insufficient/unsatisfactory cervical cytology results.
- 10. Revised declined, defer, stop screening section of dialog.

- a. Declined will resolve reminder for 12 months to be consistent with all Office of Women's Health reminders.
- b. Defer option will resolve reminder for 90 days to be consistent with all Office of Women's Health reminders.
- c. New option to document that patient does not receive primary care at this VA.
- d. New options to document patient does not have cervix.
 - i. Patient is transgender man to woman
 - ii. Congenital absence of cervix
- e. Removed the limited life expectancy <6 months option to be consistent with all Office of Women's Health reminders.
- 11. Added Return To Clinic order option to dialog.
- 12. Added Tickler/Reminder option to dialog.
- 13. Added two new reminder taxonomies for documenting procedure codes for cervical cytology and HPV testing.

Pre-Installation

1. Create a copy of the reminder inquiry output for the current VA-WH PAP SMEAR SCREENING reminder to use as a reference for mapping to the new reminder definition terms.

a. The easiest method is to right-click the reminder in CPRS and select reminder inquiry. Select all and use CTRL-C to copy. Paste in notepad.

2. Create a copy of the VA-WH PAP SMEAR SCREENING reminder dialog using the INQ option to use as a reference for mapping findings to the new reminder dialog groups and elements.

3. Identify any local findings mapped to the following reminder terms:

- a. VA-WH PAP SMEAR SCREEN DECLINED
- b. VA-WH PAP SMEAR SCREEN NOT INDICATED
- c. VA-WH PAP SMEAR DONE
- d. VA-WH PAP SMEAR ORDER

4. Identify lab tests mapped to the following terms:

The lab tests will need to be remapped during post-installation, but the condition statements will not be added back to the lab test findings.

- a. VA-WH HPV TESTING NEGATIVE
- b. VA-WH HPV TESTING POSITIVE

5. Identify the order dialog mapped to the following. These orders will need to be remapped during post-installation.

- a. Element: VA-WH PAP HPV TESTING
- b. Group: VAL-WH ORDER PAP SMEAR

6. Determine if the <u>FDA-approved HPV lab test for primary screening</u> is available locally. <u>This is not a typical HPV lab tests ordered with cervical cytology</u>. This is an HPV lab test that can be administered in lieu of cervical cytology for certain patients. Most sites do not have this lab test available. <u>Ask local Women's Health clinical leadership</u>.

7. Identify appropriate return to clinic order to include in cervical cancer screening reminder dialog.

Install Details

The file will be installed using Reminder Exchange, programmer access is not required.

Install Example

To Load the Web Host File. Navigate to Reminder exchange in Vista



At the Select Action: prompt, enter LWH for Load Web Host File

At the **Input the url for the .prd file:** prompt, type the following web address: **https://REDACTED/UPDATE_2_0_395.PRD**

The same lab tests should be mapped to each term.

Do not add a condition to the lab tests.

- a. VA-WH HPV TESTING NEGATIVE
- b. VA-WH HPV TESTING POSITIVE

3. Map local lab tests (if available) identified in pre-installation back to the following reminder terms:

Only map an HPV lab test to these terms if your Women's Health clinical leadership confirmed the lab test is a FDA approved HrHPV for primary screen lab test. Most sites do not have this lab test.

Any lab tests mapped to the VA-WH HPV TESTING NEGATIVE and VA-WH HPV TESTING POSITIVE terms **should not** also be mapped to these terms.

Do not add a condition to the lab tests.

Orderable items with the appropriate status are much more accurate as representation of an active order than health factors. Map all orderable items for ordering a pap smear/cervical cytology. Add the status of ACTIVE, RENEWED, PENDING, and SCHEDULED to each orderable item. After adding the orderable items, remove ALL health factors released in the term.
