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Introduction

 - a. Element: VAL-AHOBPR PROBLEM LIST DISPLAY
 - b. Element: VAL-AHOBPR ACTIVE MEDS DISPLAY
 - c. Element: VAL-AHOBPR ACTIVE MEDS DISPLAY IN NOTE
 - d. Element: VAL-AHOBPR TELEHEALTH LOCATION HOME
2. Identify local TIU object that displays the patient's primary care physician's name and phone number.
3. Identify local TIU object that displays the latest vital measurements.



You should see a message at the top of your screen that the file successfully loaded. Search and locate an entry titled **UPDATE_2_0_400 VA-MILITARY ENVIRONMENTAL EXPOSURE** in reminder exchange.

At the **Select Action** prompt, enter **IFE** for Install Exchange File Entry

Enter the number that corresponds with your entry UPDATE_2_0_400 VA-MILITARY ENVIRONMENTAL EXPOSURE
(In this example it is entry 618. It will vary by site). The date of the exchange file should be 09/06/2024.

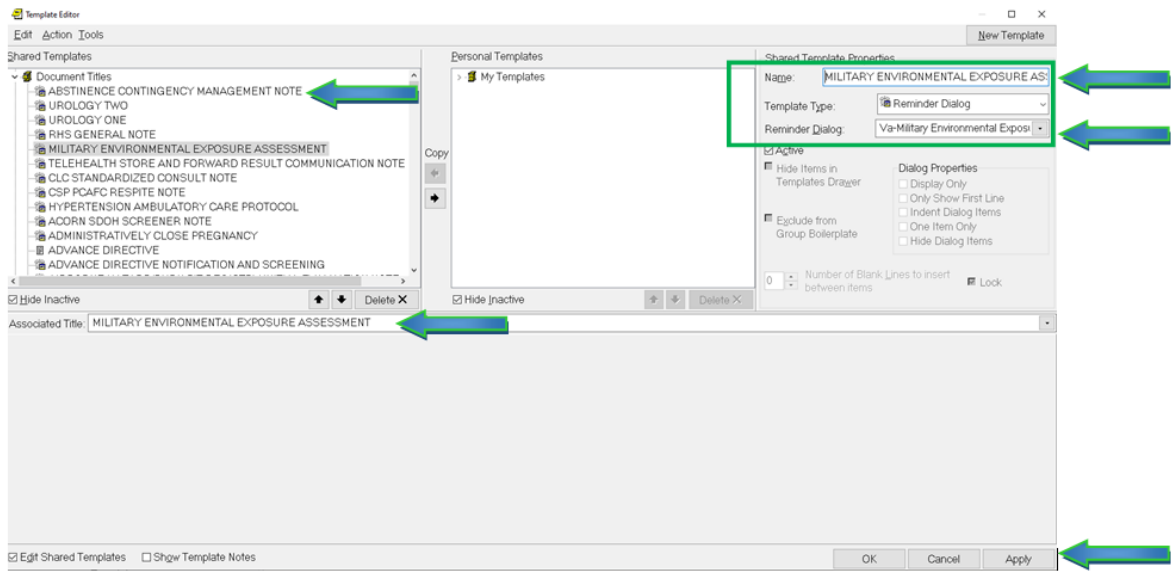
