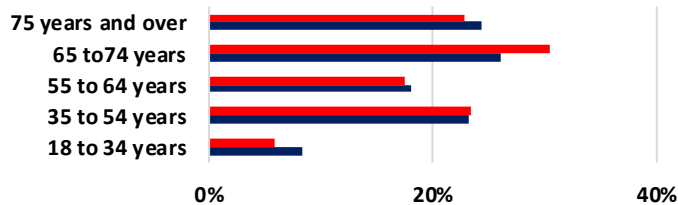

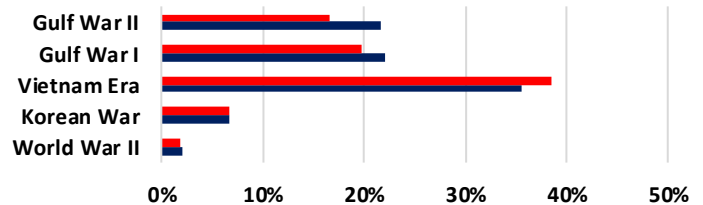
Age Distribution

West Virginia National



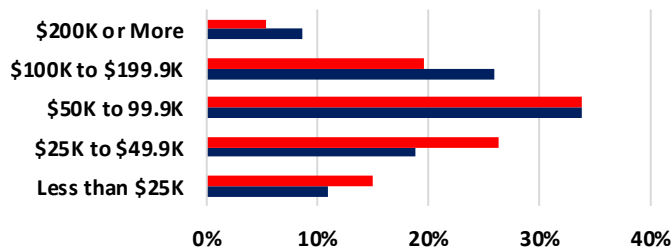
Period of Service

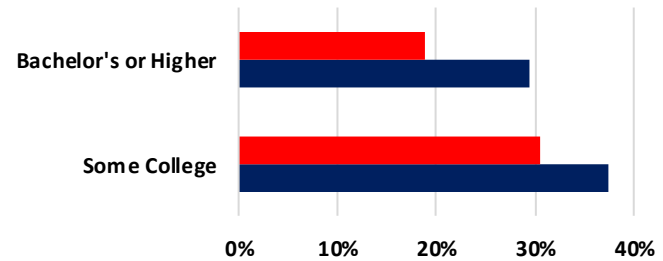
Household Income
